Taylor was never the one to keep herself restricted to one genre. She first started writing Country music. Her first two songs, 'Love Story' and 'You Belong With Me,' were generally into Country Music but stayed at the top in all genres. Her subsequent two albums, Fearless (2008) and Speak Now (2010), transitioned from country music to pop songs.

Later, her album 'Red,' extremely popular among the millennials back then, moved her from country pop to pop music. Her song 'We are never getting back together' stayed in Billboard's top 10 for 11 weeks straight. In those days, what people loved was a singer in pyjamas complaining about her ex-boyfriend was the most exciting part of the video. It followed with her album 1989.
